

## 9: What Does The Bible Say About Homosexuality?

**FB:** (from blog) The Bible implies that homosexuality, like other sins, can be overcome. Paul reminds the Corinthians that although some of them were homosexuals, they changed: “Some of you were like this; but you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God” (1Co 6:11; see vv. 9-10 for context). **FB:** (from blog) Some gay advocates try to deny that homosexuality is a sin by noting that Jesus never said anything about it. But Jesus’ silence is irrelevant. Many behaviors Jesus was silent about are addressed and prohibited elsewhere in Scripture. But all the same, what the Bible *doesn’t* say about homosexuality may in some cases be just as important as what it does say. First, the Bible doesn’t say that homosexual behavior is the worst sin. Though it’s a serious offense to God, we shouldn’t heap special condemnation on homosexuals or feel compelled to make homosexuality the special focus of our witness to a world lost in sin.
